Your notice should include the following:

- A description of the copyrighted work you believe has been infringed.
- A description of where the infringing content is located on the website.

- Your contact information (name, address, phone number, and email).
- A statement that you have a good faith/belief that the use of the content is not authorised by the copyright owner.
- A statement that the information in your notice is accurate, under penalty of perjury.

Upon receiving a valid copyright infringement notice, we will investigate the matter and take appropriate action, which may include removing or disabling access to the alleged infringing content.

Copyright Infringement Counter-Notice

If you believe that your content has been removed in error or due to a mistake, you may submit a counter-notice. Please contact us at the same email or phone listed above, providing the following details:

- A description of the content that was removed and the location where it appeared before removal.
- A statement under penalty of perjury that you believe the content was removed by mistake or misidentification.
- Your contact information (name, address, phone number, and email).
- Your consent to the jurisdiction of the courts of [your location] and that you will accept service of process from the person who filed the original notice of infringement.

We will review and respond to counter-notices within a reasonable time.
